What is a "DNS Leak"?

Each time your computer translates a hostname like eff.org to an IP address, it does so by using Domain Name System (DNS) servers. Those servers are supplied by your Internet Provider and almost always your ISP would be the one in control of them. While your Internet Provider can't see exactly what you do when you visit a domain (like eff.org), if you're using VPN, they can still see that you're visiting it.

Some VPN Apps would not force the DNS requests through their own DNS
